

Authors are required to go through the abstract submission guidelines and step-by-step instructions for submitting their work to ICVAM 2026.

Scope and Subject Area

- Submit your abstract to the most relevant subject area listed on the conference website; authors will select the subject area during submission in Microsoft [CMT](#) right after login on the Author Console.

Two-page abstract format

- To download the abstract template click on the button



- Choose any one of the Abstract Template from the docx/latex folder
- To download the latex template, you need to download the .zip file and extract it in your [Overleaf](#) account online.
- **Length:** strictly two pages, single-spaced, A4 page size, with all content (text, figures, tables, references) written in the prescribed format mentioned in the abstract template fitting within the given margins.
- **Fonts and layout:** main text in a standard readable font (Times New Roman 12 pt), fully justified, with centered title and author/affiliation block; Title/Headings should be in bold while body text remains regular.
- **Margins and line length:** do not alter margins in the provided template.
- **Figures/tables:** keep minimal and ensure good quality images.
- **References:** include maximum three references in the given format.

Author and co-author details

- Ensure that all co-authors are listed with correct names, affiliations, and a designated primary contact on the CMT submission form's "Authors" section.
- Adding a co-author by email requires that co-authors have a registered CMT account.

Subject areas and conflicts

- During submission, select the appropriate subject areas or mini symposium to route your abstract to the correct track.

File preparation and naming

- Prepare the abstract as a single .docx file (or single .pdf file in case of latex template users) that meets the two-pages format.
- Use a filename of the format

“Firstname_Lastname_ICVAM2026_Abstract.docx”or
“Firstname_Lastname_ICVAM2026_Abstract.pdf”.

Submission deadlines and edits

- Create your submission before the stated deadline. After submitting, you can edit the abstract until the deadline.

How to submit

- You must have a CMT account before attempting to submit your abstract; if you do not already have one, create it using the official CMT account creation instructions.
- **Create a CMT account:**
 - Go to the CMT login page: <https://cmt3.research.microsoft.com/User/Login> and click Register, then complete the required fields on “Create New Account,” agree to Terms of Use, and register; look for a verification email and complete the one-time verification link before logging in.
 - If the verification email does not arrive, check spam/junk, ensure your browser is up to date, clear cache for webmail.


Log in and open the Author Console:
