Sub: Proposal to waive off fee for the top 5 JEE (Advanced) rankers admitted to the **Institute starting from 2022**

The Institute is increasing its footprint in the prospective students' minds consistently. An increase in the cut off for admission to the Institute through JEE (Advanced) is a testimony to that. In order to further catapult our position and to attract the top talent to our Undergraduate programs through JEE (Advanced), it is proposed that starting from the UG batch to be admitted this year, no fee of any kind (Tuition Fee, Annual Charges, One Time charges, Other Semester Charges, Hostel charges, Mess charges etc.) be charged for four/five years from the JEE (Advanced) common rank list (CRL) top rankers among the students admitted to this Institute subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:

- (i) The student should have achieved a rank up to 600 in JEE (Advanced) 2022 in the common rank list (CRL).
- (ii) The student should be in top 5 among all the CRL rankers up to 600 rank admitted to the Institute. The Institute will bear the above mentioned expenses for their four-year/five-year study at this Institute from the IRG fund of the Institute.
- (iii) The selected students will have to maintain a consistent CGPA of 9.0 or above in each year. If the CGPA falls below 9.0 in any year or if there is a backlog in any course, the concerned student will have to pay the applicable fee from the subsequent semester.
- (iv) In case any major disciplinary action is taken against the concerned student, the fee waiver will be withdrawn and the concerned student will have to pay the applicable fee from the subsequent semester.
