The abstract shall adhere to the following:

- Length: Maximum 800 words excluding cover page.
- Margins: 2.54 cm for all sides
- Font: Times New Roman, 12 point
- **Spacing:** 1.5
- Cover page: Title, author(s), affiliation(s), contact details
- Key words: Maximum Five
- We only look for unique, unpublished content.
- The title page should appear on the first page of the abstract.
- It should include the paper's title as well as each contributor's name, title, address, phone number, and email address.
- Papers should be sent in **PDF format** only.
- Papers must be submitted to us by the deadline. Every submission will be examined, and the authors of papers that are approved will be notified by email.
- Papers that contain more than 15% plagiarism will be disqualified during the screening process.
