Selection process of Junior Coaching Assistant will be conducted in two Steps i.e. Step –I (Trade/Coaching Ability Test) and Step –II (Written Test).

**Step –I (qualifying in nature):-** Trade/Coaching Ability test – Total 100 Marks (as per the advertisement).

**Step II :- Written test – 100 Marks** (as per the advertisement).

Syllabus for Written test will be as per the Diploma in Coaching prescribed by Sports Authority of India for the relevant sports/game. [Notified vide Notice No. 423345/2022-ESTT. dated 29.12.2022]

Answer scripts of Step- II (Written Test) will be evaluated in respect of only those candidates who qualify the Step-I.

On the basis of marks obtained in Step – II i.e. Written Test (subject to obtaining the minimum cut off marks), candidates may be provisionally shortlisted for Document Verification.

Final merit list of the candidates (who qualify in the Trade/Coaching ability Test) for selection will be prepared based on their performance (marks obtained) in the Written Test subject to successful verification of the relevant Documents required for the eligibility.

**Tie-breaking Criteria for Document verification / final merit list for the post of Junior Coaching Assistant**

In case two or more candidates secure equal marks against same vacancy in Written Test, following methodology will be adopted for final selection:

- Candidate securing more marks in Step-I i.e. Trade/ Coaching Ability test is to be shortlisted/ selected.
- In case two or more candidates secure equal marks in both Written Test (Step-II) and Trade/ Coaching Ability test (Step-I), candidate senior in Age is to be ranked higher.

**Document Verification:-**

The candidates shortlisted for document verification, on the basis of performance in Written Test, will have to produce the following documents in original (as mentioned in the advertisement) in support of their eligibility:

- Matriculation certificate in support of Date of Birth
- Mark sheet of educational qualifications
- Certificate of educational qualifications
- Experience certificate
- Certificate (in GoI format) on the basis of which Age Relaxation has been claimed like. Ex-serviceman certificate, Meritorious sports person certificate, PwD certificate, etc.

- (vi) No Objection Certificate from the present employer (if they are employed in Central Govt./ State Govt./ Union Territory Administration/ Central or State Autonomous Bodies/ Central or State PSUs) etc.

In addition, the following documents are also required to be produced for the verification:

**For OBC-NCL Category:** Valid OBC-NCL certificate issued on or after 01.04.2022 by the Competent Authority in the format prescribed for appointment under Govt. of India.

**For SC/ST Category:** Valid caste/Tribe/Category certificate issued by the competent authority in the format prescribed for appointment under Govt. of India.

**For EWS Category:** Valid EWS certificate issued for the year 2022 or financial year 2022-2023 by the competent authority in the format prescribed for appointment under Govt. of India.

In case, failing to produce the above documents, their candidature will be cancelled and they will not be selected against the vacancy of the posts, even on passing the Written Test.

Admit cards to candidates for Junior Coaching Assistant will be available from 18.01.2023.
