

INTRODUCTION

To cope up with multidimensional complexities that include constrained resources, limited time schedules, and environmental issues, and great uncertainties involved in managing a mining project, new management perspectives, viewpoints, and advanced techniques are required that are different from traditional approaches. Knowledge on financial management is also critical for effective handling of coal mining projects. This program provides the managers with a comprehensive working knowledge of various critical issues pertaining to operational and financial aspects of project management in coal mining industry. The proposed course incorporates the application of project software and spreadsheet applications for solving various critical issues relating to mining projects. The program will include 18 sessions on Sustainable Development of Mining Projects and Star Ratings of Mines, Strategic Financial Management, Project Planning and Scheduling with Application Software, Risk Analysis and Management with Simulation Software, Costing Issues, and Working Capital Management on Mining Projects, Financial Appraisal of Projects and Financial Statement Analysis, Social Impact Assessment, and Sustainable Investment in Projects. This program will help the participants to take up the challenge of implementing the complex coal mining projects.

- The main objective of this program is to equip the participants with various tools, techniques, and managerial issues through interactive lecture sessions and discussions with case examples.
- This program will provide hands-on experience to the senior executives/officers/engineers of coal companies with latest tools & techniques of project and financial management using application software's.
