## JOINT 5-YEAR INTEGRATED DUAL DEGREE PROGRAM WITH IIM MUMBAI

The Institute is pleased to announce signing of MOU with IIM Mumbai to offer a joint 5-year Integrated Dual Degree Program that leads to award of a B.Tech degree in relevant discipline along with a diploma in management from IIT (ISM) Dhanbad, and an MBA degree from IIM Mumbai. The salient features of this joint 5-year Integrated Dual Degree program are enclosed herewith. The template of this program and other UG programs are also enclosed for the information of all.

Applications will soon be invited from the existing B.Tech students who will pre-register next month for their 4<sup>th</sup> / 6<sup>th</sup> Semester (WS 2024-25). The interested students can submit their interest during online pre-registration for WS 2024-25 as per the details provided in the Pre-registration notification to be issued for WS 2024-25 in due course.

From the Academic year 2025-26, the applications for this program will be sought from the 1<sup>st</sup> year B.Tech students during their pre-registration for 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester (Monsoon Semester).

### SALIENT FEATURES OF JOINT 5-YEAR INTEGRATED DUAL DEGREE PROGRAM OF

### IIT (ISM) DHANBAD AND IIM MUMBAI

- (i) Applications will be sought from the interested B.Tech students of IIT (ISM) Dhanbad at the end of their second semester based on their CGPA (Minimum CGPA required at the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester will be 7.50). No CAT score will be required for application.
- (ii) The selected students will be allowed to join IIM Mumbai after completion of their 7<sup>th</sup> semester (provided there is no course backlog remaining at the end of 7<sup>th</sup> Semester and their CGPA at that time is also at least 7.50).
- (iii) The maximum no. of students allowed to join this program will be 15. Based on the no. and quality of applications received for this program, the Institute may impose additional criteria to shortlist the required number of applicants. IIM Mumbai may also Interview the candidates before final selection.
- (iv) There will be 12 pre-requisite courses of MBA that are required to be completed at IIT (ISM) Dhanbad. The list of those 12 courses is enclosed.
- (v) The selected students will complete the 12 pre-requisite courses of MBA in place of their Minor/Honours courses of B.Tech (NEP regime) and other course slots prescribed for the regular Dual Degree Category C template of this Institute. The program template to be followed by students enrolled for Joint 5 year Dual Degree Program is enclosed.
- (vi) Some of the 12 pre-requisite courses may also be offered during Summer Semesters, if possible.
- (vii) The B.Tech final year 10 credit project may be completed by such students by the time they complete their 7<sup>th</sup> Semester.
- (viii)Upon fulfilment of all the requirements and successful completion of this Dual Degree program at the respective Institutes, a B.Tech Degree (in relevant discipline with a Diploma in Management discipline) will be awarded by IIT (ISM) Dhanbad and an MBA degree will be awarded by IIM Mumbai.
- (ix) The B.Tech degree will be awarded to such students along with their batch mates of B.Tech during the convocation at IIT (ISM) Dhanbad. The MBA degree will be awarded to such students by IIM Mumbai, along with their batch mates of MBA, in the convocation of IIM Mumbai.
- (x) In case any selected student fails to fulfil the criterion of having a minimum CGPA of 7.5 at the end of 7<sup>th</sup> semester or fails to fulfil the criterion of having no backlog course at the end of 7<sup>th</sup> semester, he/she will not be allowed to join IIM Mumbai. Such students will have to complete their 8<sup>th</sup> semester at this Institute only and upon successful completion of the same, they will be awarded only a B.Tech Degree (in relevant discipline with a Diploma in Management discipline). No MBA degree will be awarded to them.
- (xi) The 15 students enrolled in this program shall be able to participate in the placement process only at one of the two Institutes as per their choice. An NOC from CDC Chairperson, IIT (ISM) Dhanbad will be required to be submitted at IIM Mumbai if any of these 15 selected students wishes to avail the placement opportunities at IIM Mumbai. IIM Mumbai will ensure to provide equal placement opportunities, at par with their regular MBA students, to all such students who submit the NoC from the CDC Chairperson, IIT (ISM) Dhanbad to IIM Mumbai.
- (xii) The applicable MBA Program fee of IIM Mumbai will be paid by the selected students before joining IIM Mumbai. Currently, the program fee for 5<sup>th</sup> year is Rs.21 Lakhs as on 21<sup>st</sup> October 2024 and is likely to change in future as per the decision of IIM Mumbai.
