INSTRUCTIONS TO DEGREE RECIPIENTS

1. The degree recipients will be required to adhere to the dress code for the convocation. Students will not be allowed to enter in the convocation hall without prescribed dress. The dress code for the degree recipient is as under:

Boys: Off-White/ Pale Cream Kurta & Pyjama (Preferably Chudidar) and Formal Sandals along with Stole. The students may wear khadi/woolen jacket/ sweater of matching light colour, if they so desire. The Stole will be provided at the Institute to registered students.

Girls: Off-White/ Pale Cream Salwar+Kamij (Preferably Chudidar) or Off-White Saree with Matching Clothes and appropriate footwear along with Stole. The girls may wear khadi/woolen jacket/ sweater of matching light colour, if they so desire. The Stole will be provided at the Institute to registered students.

2. All recipients of degrees should occupy their respective seats indicated on the chairs in the Convocation Venue (Penman Auditorium) before scheduled time as given below:

3. The seating arrangement for accompanying persons will be at GJLT with live telecast. There will also be live webcast of the programme for which can be viewed through institute website.
4. Few seats will be available for parents/spouse in the Penman Auditorium on first-come, first-serve basis.
5. **Medals** will be presented to the eligible candidates by the Chief Guest/Chairman in the first half to **all medalist/ awardees of all programmes (B.Tech/Dual Degree/Integrated/M.Sc./M.Sc.Tech/ MBA/ M.Tech)**. are required to be present in the Penman Hall during first half (09:15 AM)
6. All recipients must remain on their seats till adjournment of the Convocation and should not leave the Hall mid-way.
7. The Director will admit the recipients for their respective degrees. The awardees should stand up for the ceremony.

9. After the pledge is taken, Degrees will be distributed by the Director. On starting of the degree awarding ceremony, the recipients shall form a queue in order of their seats and move on to the dais immediately on their names being called. The order of award of degrees will be B.Tech, Dual Degree, Integrated (in first sitting), Ph.D, M.Sc., M.Sc.Tech, MBA, (in second seating) and M. Tech, (in third seating).

10. The recipients of degree, on his/her name being called, shall go the dais from the left side (as viewed by the audience) and bow his/her head before the dignitaries on the dais and receive the degree from the Director. He/She should then get down from the dais from the right side and occupy his/her seat.
