NOTICE FOR TUTION FEE WAIVER FOR STUDENTS ADMITTED THROUGH JEE (ADVANCED) DURING 2016 FOR REGISTRATION DURING 2017-18 SESSION

The MHRD vide its Notification No F.No.24-2/2016 TS1 dated 8th April 2016 has revised the Tuition Fee and has approved revision of tuition fee to Rs. 2.00 Lakh a year from the Academic Year 2016-17, and allowed tuition fee waiver as follows:

- a) The most economically backward students (whose family income is less than Rs 1.00 Lakh per annum) shall get full remission of the tuition fee.
- b) The other economically backward students (whose family income is between Rs. 1.00 Lakh to Rs. 5.00 Lakh per annum) shall get remission of 2/3rd of the tuition fee.

Accordingly, the JEE (Advanced) admitted students during 2016-17 session, who are eligible *to avail Tuition Fee Waiver/ Concession during 2017-18 academic year*, are advised to submit their application in prescribed format (Annexure-I) alongwith parental income certificate (for the period 1.4.2016 to 31.3.2017) duly signed by Competent Authority to The Assistant Registrar (Examination & Academic), Indian Institute of Technology (Indian School of Mines) Dhanbad, Administrative Block, Dhanbad- 826004. The last date for submission of application for tuition fee waiver (2017-18) is 12.06.2017.

It may also be noted that the Income Certificate to be submitted should have been issued by the Competent Authority indicated in Annexure-II. In case of false certificate, the institute shall have full rights to take suitable action against student/ parent/ guardian, as the case may be. A list of identified Competent Authorities for issuing Income Certificate is available at Annexure – II.

The completed application along with supporting documents should reach the office of Assistant Registrar (Examination & Academic) by 12.06.2017. The delayed/ incomplete application will be summarily rejected. All concerned eligible students are advised to submit the application at the earliest for consideration.
