NOTICE INVITING TENDER

Tenders in the prescribed form are hereby invited for **“Fabrication of 20 Nos. of barricades { 5 feet(height) x 4 2/3 feet (length) x 1 1/3 feet(width)} of Campus Administration Section in Workshop”**

Estimated cost: Rs. 2.124 Lakhs

1. Tender documents consisting of materials and work specifications, drawing and format of financial bid quantity of works to be executed and the set of “conditions of contract” to be complied with by the person whose tenders may be accepted and which will also be found in tender documents. Tender documents may downloaded from IIT(ISM) website www.iitism.ac.in. The downloaded tender documents must be submitted alongwith Security deposit in form of Demand Draft from a Nationalised bank in favour of Registrar ,IIT(ISM) Dhanbad.
2. The site of the work is Workshop IIT(ISM) Dhanbad
3. Tender documents should always be placed in sealed cover with the tender notice No., name of the work, date and time of the opening written on the envelopes will be received by Associate Professor(Workshop) and opened in his office as per details given below:

Last date of receipt/submission of tender is 21.02.2018 up to 3:00 PM.

Date and time of opening of tender is 21.02.2018 up to 4:00 PM.

The time allowed for the work completion will be 30(**Thirty**) days which shall be reckoned from 10th day after the date of issue of letter of acceptance.

4. **Security Deposit amounting to Rs 5000.00** in the form of demand draft from a nationalized bank in favour of “Registrar, IIT(ISM) Dhanbad” must accompany each tender in a sealed cover super-scribed with “EMD for Tender No. _____” and addressed to Associate Professor (Workshop), IIT(ISM), Dhanbad.
5. Security Deposit of unsuccessful bidders will be refunded without any interest. Security Deposit of successful bidder will be refunded without interest after execution of order and completion of warranty period of three months from the date of successful acceptance of items. In case of failure of execution of order or satisfactory service during warranty period Security deposit will be forfeited.
6. The competent authority does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the tenders received without the assignment of any reason. All tenders in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the tenderer shall be summarily rejected.
7. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenderers is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection
8. The competent authority reserves himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and the tenderer shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
9. The tender for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of opening of tenders/ninety (90) days from the date of opening of financial bid in case tenders are invited on 2 envelop system. If any tenderer withdraws his tender before said period or issue of letter of acceptance, whichever is earlier, or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable to the department, then the IIT(ISM) shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit the said earnest money as aforesaid. Further the tenderer shall not be allowed to participate in the retendering process of the work.
10. An item rate tender containing percentage below/above will be summarily rejected, however a tender voluntarily offers a rebate, this may be considered.
11. On acceptance of the tender the name of the accredited representative(s) of the contractor who would be responsible for taking instructions from the Associate Professor (Workshop) shall be communicated to Associate Professor (Workshop).
12. The contractors should quote in figures as well as in words the rate and the amount tendered by them. The amount for each item should be worked out and requisite total to be given.
13. Goods & Service Tax (GST) as applicable in respect of this contract shall be payable by the contractor and IIT(ISM) will not entertain any claim whatsoever in this respect. GST will be paid along with the contractor’s bill.
14. Rates quoted by the contractor in item rate tender in figures and words shall be accurately filled in so that there is no discrepancy in the rates written in figures and words. However, if a discrepancy is found the rates which correspond with the amount worked out by the contractor shall be taken as correct.
15. If the amount of an item is not worked out by the contractor or it does not correspond with the rate written either in figure or in words then the rate quoted by the contractor in words shall be taken as correct.
16. Where the rates quoted by the contractor in figures and in words tally but the amount is not worked out correctly, the rate quoted by the contractor will be taken as correct and not the amount.

Specification of raw materials for 20 Nos. of barricades { 5 feet(height) x 4 2/3 feet(length) x 1 1/3 feet(width)}

- i. Pipes: (a) Hollow: 2” OD x 1.5 mm thickness MS round, 40 feet length
(b) Solid Round: 1” diameter MS, 44” length
- ii. Wire/mesh: 1”x 1” x 3 mm Dia square net, 24 square feet.
- iii. Sheet: 18 Gauge(1.22 mm), 12”x 54”
- iv. Flat: MS flat 25 mm x 5 mm 1 feet length
- v. Angles: 1”x 1” x 3 mm, 36 feet length
- vi. Wheels: Cast Iron rubber coated 6” diameter (04 pieces) with 1” ID x 2.5 mm thick washer (08 pieces).
- vii. Attachment Clamps: 0.5” MS rod x 3 feet
- viii. Paint: 0.9 litre(Yellow) +0.1 litres (White)
- ix. Primer: 1 litre
- x. Thinner: 0.5 litre
- xi. Emery cloth: 10 pieces (120 No.)
- xii. Welding electrode: 40 pieces (10 No.)
- xiii. Miscellaneous, if any

- (iii) All raw materials of components may be cut as per sizes and may be welded with good quality of welding electrodes and may assembled wherever needed in order to a frame .
- (iv) The whole frame may be cleaned with emery paper and cloth and may be painted with good quality of paint(yellow colour)
- (v) 04 Nos. of wheels of good quality may be fitted in all frames
- (vi) 02 Nos. of attachment clamps may be manufactured and may be attached.
- (vii) 1 Round SECURITY IIT(ISM) DHANBAD (4” x 4” approx.) will be written in red color in white background in both sides
