The last date for the receipt of application for the above mentioned scholarship is 27.03.2023 in the office of Dean (Students Welfare).

Eligiblity Criteria:

- Needy, poor and meritorious students will be given one time assistance from Benevolent fund, whose family income does not exceed Rs. 2,00,000/- per annum and who is not getting any scholarship/stipend from any other sources.
- Students passing from regular/summer semester examination with CGPA 7.5 and above for UG and 8.0 and above for PG will be eligible for this assistance. The students should not take more than minimum stipulated period to complete his/her programme. The students having year back will not be eligible for the assistance.
- There should not be any disciplinary action / pending against the students applying for the benevolent fund.
- The maximum amount to be awarded to a student from the benevolent fund shall be equivalent to the 50% of annual tuition fee or Rs. 50,000/- whichever is less.
- The students availed any other scholarship / stipend / free-ship in earlier semester will not be eligible to get assistance in later semester from this fund.
- The students availed any other scholarship / stipend / free-ship in current semester will not be eligible to get assistance in later semester from this fund.
