The merit cum means sponsorship /scholarship will encompass the complete expenses incurred from start to finish of the enrolled **B. Tech/ Integrated M. Tech / M.Sc Tech** courses.

The proposed scholarship will cover the student's expenses incurred during his/her entire course of study in the bachelor/PG programs offered by the institute in Petroleum Engineering, Applied Geology, Mechanical Engineering and Environmental Science & Engineering.

Methodology:

Recommendation from the institute
Family income – Ceiling – Rs. 8.00 lakhs.

Ranking of the Entrance Examinations/CGPA (minimum CGPA 7.5 or above)

Personal interview with student and parents (two stages) First by the institute and ii) by the Officials of Bobby Mohanty Foundation.

Students once selected shall continue to avail the financial assistance till the fourth/final year with minimum CGPA of 7.5 and above to be eligible for the scholarship.

Students selected under this scheme shall not be eligible for Fee Waiver/MCM or any other scholarships.
