NOTICE

AWARD OF TWELVE SANDVIK SCHOLARSHIP for 2nd Year B.Tech and Dual Degree (Mining Engineering) students of Indian Institute of Technology (ISM) Dhanbad for the session 2022-23.

Applications in prescribed format are invited for award of the Sandvik Scholarship so as to reach the office of the undersigned on or before 20.01.2023 (5.00 P.M.), as per details below: **Delayed/Incomplete applications will not be considered.**

1. For this purpose, family income certificate is required instead of individual income certificate.
2. Those who cannot submit family income certificate may submit individual income certificate of parents (father and mother separately). Certificate issued from proper issuing authority of the concerned with proper seal. If the family income exceed Rs. 2.50 lakhs please also enclosed the copy of ITR (F.Y. – 2021-22, Assessment year 2022-23). Affidavit or copy of ITR only will not be considered as income proof.
3. In case, where single parents is surviving, income certificate of survivor will be sufficient. In such cases the applicant has to submit death certificate/affidavit of the deceased.
4. Copies of grade sheet of previous semesters and copy of up to date (last paid) fee receipt.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- (i) Income of the family should not be more than Rs. 6,00,000/- during the financial year (2021-22).
- (ii) Income Certificate must be issued on or after 01.04.2022 (financial year 2021-22 and Income Tax Assessment year 2022-23).
- (iii) Applicant should have passed regular semester examination minimum OGPA of 6.00 out of 10.00 (a Xerox copy of previous academic GPA cards must be attached). For students having Summer/Special examination, minimum GPA requirement is 7.00 out of 10. Students having Disciplinary action against them will be debarred from award of Scholarship.
- (iv) These scholarships may be continued in 3rd and 4th year if they continue to have good academic performance.
- (v) A student need to have a good academic record of previous year and is eligible for next year only on maintaining the grades with OGPA of 6.00 or more in 10 points grading.
- (vi) Students qualified under this scholarship will not be eligible for any other Scholarship.
- (vii) Number of scholarship in the current year – 12.
- (viii) Amount of yearly scholarship – Rs. 1.00 lakh per students
- (ix) A list showing the family income issuing Authority (State wise) is enclosed.

Documents required to be submitted

- (i) Duly filled in application form (ii) Family income certificate (iii) Grade sheet (IV) Identity Card. (v) Aaddhar Card of Parents and ITR as applicable.
