Skill Development Initiative Equips Youth for Employment, Around 150 Certificates Awarded at IIT (ISM)

The Department of Mining Engineering at IIT (ISM) Dhanbad organised the **Skill Certificate Distribution Ceremony 2026** at the TEXMiN Seminar Hall on Thursday, marking the successful completion of the Assistant Mine Surveyor training programme conducted under **Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) 4.0**, Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE), and the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC).

A total of **147 certificates** were distributed during the ceremony, including **85 trainees** who successfully completed the three-month Assistant Mine Surveyor course and **62 trainers** who were recognised for their contribution to the programme. He noted that participants received hands-on exposure in modern mine surveying techniques from IIT (ISM) faculty, technical officers and experienced professionals from BCCL, SBI and other organisations. "Our objective is to develop competent professionals who are ready to contribute to the mining and infrastructure sectors from day one," he said.

Dr. Sunil Kumar, Course Coordinator, said the programme successfully blended classroom instruction with practical training and industry interaction. He informed that **32 trainees have recently secured jobs through campus placements**, reflecting the quality of training and the growing demand for skilled Assistant Mine Surveyors.

Sharing her experience, trainee **Diksha Kumari** said the opportunity to undergo training at IIT (ISM) under PMKVY has enhanced her technical skills and confidence. She described the certificate as a significant milestone in her career and said she would soon join a company in Kolkata.

Among those present were **Prof. Alok Kumar Das, Dean (Innovation, Incubation & Entrepreneurship)**, faculty members, technical officers, representatives from industry partners, trainers, trainees and their family members. The programme concluded with the distribution of certificates and a vote of thanks.
