A host of competitions lined up for Hindi Pakhwada at IIT (ISM) Dhanbad from September 19.

A host of programs are lined up for the Hindi Pakhwada being organized at IIT (ISM) Dhanbad as per the direction of the Department of Official Language, which will begin on September 19 with the poetry reading meant both for the Hindi and non-Hindi speaking staff, faculty members, and officers.

The admin building's conference hall will host an hour-long Hindi poetry reading for both Hindispeaking and non-Hindi-speaking staff starting at 4 p.m. on September 19, followed by the same event meant for both the Hindi and non Hindi speaking faculty members/officers at the same venue from 5 p.m.

A competition meant to test the knowledge of the official language policy will be held at the New Lecture Hall Complex of the institute on September 23 from 5.30 p.m. This will be followed by a note and typewriting competition in Hindi meant for all, including, faculty members, officers, and staff, scheduled at the ground floor of NLHC on September 24, 2024, from 6 p.m.

An essay writing competition for all students, including the research scholar on Artificial Intelligence and Jobs of the Future, will be held on the ground floor of the New Lecture Hall Complex on September 25.

1st, 2nd, and 3rd winners of every competition will be provided Rs 3000, Rs 2000, and Rs 1000 as cash prizes, respectively, besides the certificates. However, the three top winners of the competition will be rewarded only when the number of participants will be eight or more than eight, but if the number of participants will be five, then only two winners will be awarded.
