Three remarkable individuals were honored, including two former faculty members, who have significantly enriched the legacy of IIT (ISM).

The **Basant Samman** Awardees for 2025 included:

- Shri Gurdeep Singh, Chairman & Managing Director of NTPC, recognized for his exceptional leadership since 2016.
- **Professor Gurdeep Singh**, a 1983 Ph.D. graduate in Applied Chemistry and former Head of the Department of Environmental Science and Engineering.
- **Professor VP Sharma**, an esteemed academic with four decades of distinguished service in the Petroleum Engineering Department.

In addition, seven other notable alumni were felicitated for their extraordinary achievements. They included:

- **Professor Dilip K. Prasad**, Full Professor at UiT-The Arctic University of Norway, awarded the "Research & Academic Excellence Award."
- Shri Pankaj Satija, Distinguished Mining Engineer, honored with the "Bhaskar Bhattacharjee Memorial Award."
- Shri Tarun Sharma, Co-founder and CEO of mCaffeine, recognized with the "Young Alumnus Achiever Award."
- Shri Atul Kumar, Gold Medalist in Petroleum Engineering (1967), awarded the "Nagendra Kumar Memorial Award."
- Dr. Ragula Bhaskar, Mining Engineering 1981 graduate, who received the "Entrepreneurship Award."
- **Dr. Rajeshwar Singh**, Mining Engineering 1996 graduate and distinguished MLA from Uttar Pradesh, honored with the "Director's Award for Service to Society."
- Shri Ujjwal Tah, Director General at the Directorate General of Mines Safety, awarded for his distinguished service in the field of mining safety.



Adding to the jubilant mood, this year's event also celebrated the **Golden Jubilee** of the 1975 batch and the **Silver Jubilee** of the 2000 batch, bringing together alumni from these milestone years.

The event also resonated with deep significance as it was held in the backdrop of the upcoming **Centenary Celebrations** of IIT (ISM), Dhanbad. The remarkable contributions of alumni continue to strengthen the institute's legacy, with notable donations such as the recent contribution of **Rs. 1 Crore by Amrit Sagar Chopra**, a 1961 Mining Engineering graduate, to support the Centenary Fund.
