He elaborated upon crucial thematic domains encompassing the preparation and execution of expenditure plans; judicious utilisation of funds; scrupulous accounting practices; adherence to transparent financial protocols; regular and methodical auditing procedures; and the systematic upkeep of official registers.

This excursion served to contextualize their learning within the socio-economic realities of industrial and mining geographies.
