Dr. Suvrokamal Dutta Addresses Orientation Program at IIT (ISM) Dhanbad Highlights India's Rise on Global Stage, Wishes Success for Institute's Centenary Year

The session began with a formal introduction by **Prof. Rajni Singh, Dean (Corporate Communications)**, who highlighted **Dr. Suvrokamal Dutta's life journey, educational background, and professional accomplishments**. He also emphasized that **India is on track to become the world's leading economy by 2040**, surpassing other global giants, while also pointing to **China's economic decline** caused by the long-term impact of the Covid-19 pandemic.

Dr. Dutta urged the students to take pride in India's civilizational values and to contribute meaningfully to its technological, economic, and strategic advancement. His powerful message resonated with the audience, igniting thoughtful engagement and curiosity among the new entrants.
