Series of literary competitions kick-starts at IIT (ISM) with the inauguration of Hindi Pakhwada

As per the direction of Department of Official Language, like every year Hindi Pakhwada is being organized in IIT (ISM) Dhanbad, which was inaugurated today at Management Hall of institute by Prof JK Pattanayak, Officiating Director of the institute in presence of others, including Prabodh Pandey, Registrar; Sanjeev Anand Sahu, Associate Dean, Rajbhasa Karyanwayan and Brijesh Kumar Pandey, Assistant Registrar.

Speaking during the occasion as chief guest, Prof Pattanayak, gave details of the different competitions scheduled under the Hindi Pakhwada as per which a Hindi Recitation competition will be conducted at the conference hall of administrative building of the institute tomorrow (September 20) from 4 p.m. for the employees as well as for faculty members and officers of the institute.

He also informed the gathering that the Department of Official Language of the Ministry of Home Affairs is making continuous efforts for promotion of Hindi through, motivation, encouragement and goodwill. Prabodh Pandey, Registrar of IIT (ISM) while addressing the gathering gave details of the different official work being performed in the institute in the Hindi.

Sanjeev Anand Sahu, Associate Dean, Rajbhasa Karyanwayan, while speaking during the occasion elaborated about the series of events scheduled during the Hindi Pakhwada including Essay writing competitions.

Notably besides the Hindi recitation competition scheduled on September 20, official language policy knowledge related competition is also scheduled on September 22 for employees, faculty and officers at the same venue from 5 p.m.

The institute will also organize, a Hindi note and draft writing competition for all its employees only on September 22 in the conference hall of the of the administrative building on September 22.

An essay writing competition for all categories of students including, the research scholars will be held on September 26 on the subject-Vartman Bharat: Bhavishya Ka Vishwaguru at the ground floor of New Lecture Hall Complex on May 26 at around 5 p.m.

The fortnight long program will conclude on September 29 with the prize distribution among the winners of different competitions.

Notably, the first three winners of different competitions will be provided cash prize worth Rs 3000, Rs 2000 and Rs 1000 respectively and they will also be provided a certificate.
