IIT (ISM) Alumnus Shri Sanjiv Kumar Singh Appointed as Chairman-Cum-Managing Director of Hindustan Copper Limited

His tenure at CIL saw him serving at various locations, including Ranchi and Nagpur, before his departure in 2004.

Shri Singh later joined NTPC in March 2008 as Senior Manager (Mining) in Uttar Pradesh, where he played a key role in enhancing mining operations. He was promoted to Additional General Manager (Mining) in 2012, a position he held for over nine years before becoming General Manager in January 2022. His tenure at NTPC was marked by his contributions to mining strategy, cost optimization, and operational excellence. In March 2022, he took on the role of Director (Mining) at HCL, where he was instrumental in reviving dormant mines and integrating advanced technologies to improve efficiency and sustainability.
