IIT (ISM) Dhanbad Workshop Empowers Tribal Women in West Bengal through Entrepreneurship and Millet-Based Enterprise Development

The second day of the three-day workshop on "Designing and Delivering Capacity Building Programme for High Quality Millet Cultivation to Empower Tribal Women Entrepreneurs in West Bengal" witnessed an engaging and insightful session led by Mr. Sumit Layek, a renowned Agri-Business Expert.

The highly interactive session inspired participants to explore innovative business ideas, adopt digital tools for marketing, and pursue self-reliance through entrepreneurship.

The workshop also showcased the collaborative fieldwork and training efforts of the IIT (ISM) Dhanbad project team — Mr. Rohit Singh, Ms. Sumana Banerjee, Mr. Sunny Kumar, and Mr. Firdaus Ansari — who have been facilitating community engagement, training delivery, and smooth execution of the programme.
