IIT (ISM) Dhanbad Organizes Joint Brainstorming Session at EMRS Schools in Tundi and Palganj to Strengthen Tribal Digital Empowerment Initiatives

In a significant step towards enhancing digital literacy among tribal youth in Jharkhand, a joint brainstorming session was organized today at EMRS School, Tundi (Dhanbad) and EMRS Palganj (Giridih) under the leadership of Prof. Rashmi Singh and Prof. Niladri Das from the Department of Management Studies & Industrial Engineering, IIT (ISM) Dhanbad.

The event is part of the ongoing Centre of Excellence (CoE) initiative funded by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India, and is a key component of the Capacity Building Training Programmes on Basic and Advanced Level Information Technology and Computer Training for Tribals in Jharkhand.
