## IIT (ISM) celebrates 79th Independence Day with patriotic fervour and community spirit

IIT (ISM) Dhanbad celebrated the 79th Independence Day with pride and enthusiasm at the Oval Ground of the campus. The event began with the hoisting of the National Flag by **Prof. Sukumar Mishra, Director, IIT (ISM) Dhanbad**, followed by the National Anthem. Faculty members, officers, staff, students, alumni, and their families joined the celebration, reflecting the unity and diversity of the institute community.

At the start of his address, Prof. Mishra recalled the monumental success of the institute's **45th Convocation**, during which IIT (ISM) had the honour of hosting the **Hon'ble President of India**, as the Chief Guest in its centenary year. Following the flag hoisting, a **Tiranga Yatra** was organised by the **Office of the Dean Students' Welfare**, in which students, faculty, and staff marched from the Oval Ground to the main gate of the institute carrying the National Flag and chanting patriotic slogans. At the main gate, students staged a **nukkad natak** titled "Azadi: Tohfa Ya Jimmewari", portraying the responsibilities that come with freedom and inspiring the audience to contribute towards nation-building.

The day also featured community initiatives, including a **Blood Donation Camp** and **Free Eye Check-up Camp** organised by **Fast Forward India**, which drew active participation from students, staff, and local residents.
