"The series of competitions, right from the Technical Club Events and Animation & Game Design Contest to Aeronautics and Space Technology related events like Preparing Glider, Data and Software Technology Event, including those related to cyber security, Electronics and IOT Club events, Robotronics and Fintech Club Events are aimed to test the ability of participating budding techies to combine their technical knowledge with practical problems" said Kumar.

Divulging more details, Ankit Aryan, a B Tech, Final Year Electrical Engineering student who is also the event head said, "As part of technical club events students will be participating in Game Jam-a contest related to creating any game; Game-E-Heart related to creating animation; E sports —in which e sports events like Valvorant and FIFA will be played".

"During the Aeronautics and Space Club events participants will be pitched against each other in the competitions like-**Sky is the Limit**, during which they will be required to prepare a glider; **Pseudo Pilots** during which they will be competing designing the basic drone flight controller" further said Aryan.

"We will also be having events of different other department like Petroleum Engineering Department event –Hold Your Barge during which the participants will be required to prepare a Barge/Ship using Plastic Straw; besides the similar events of Environment Department, Chemical Department, Computer Science & Engineering Department, Mechanical Department, Electrical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Electronics & Communication and Engineering Physics" said other B Tech Final Year student, Aman Mittal who is the overall coordinator of the event.

"We will also have the prominent speakers like IPS officer cum prominent educationist, Abhyanand and Civil Servant cum Educationist cum Motivational Speaker cum Author-Tanu Jain as our guest speakers who will be motivating the students" said event Co Head-Atla Vishnu Vikash.
