<u>Newly admitted students of IIT (ISM) get acquainted with general rules of campus & Hostel regulations and also about cultural & students activities during the two day orientation programme</u>

More than 1100 newly admitted B Tech students of IIT (ISM) were apprised about the activities of different student clubs, societies, technical clubs and fests today during the 2nd day of orientation programme of fresher students held at Penman Auditorium of the institute today.

The session began during the morning at 9 am with the brief introduction about the aims of objectives of Students' Gymkhana – the student body of the institute by its member Devesh Kumar Singh, which was followed by a short description of the election rules and schedule of the student body.

A detailed description of different technical clubs of institute, including Data and Software Technology Club, FinTech Club, Animation & Game Designing Club, Aeronautics and Space Technology Club- many of which are operating under the innovation hub, Naresh Vashisht Centre for Tinkering and Innovation (NVCTI) was also given to the newcomers during the occasion by Student's Gymkhana member-Kailash Patel.

The students were also apprised about the four major fests of the institute, including Srijan- One of Biggest Cultural Fest held during the month of February, Concetto-techno Managerial fest held during October and Parakram-The sports Festival and Alumni Fest-Basant both of which are also held in February.

A colourful cultural programme organized by the Student Gymkhana is also scheduled during the evening for the newcomers from 5 pm onwards.
