Jharkhand School Innovation Challenge (JH-SIC) 2024 Grand Finale at IIT (ISM) Dhanbad

The prestigious Jharkhand School Innovation Challenge (JH-SIC) 2024 concluded with an exciting Grand Finale at the Golden Jubilee Lecture Theatre (GJLT), IIT (ISM) Dhanbad. The event, organized by the Naresh Vashisht Centre for Tinkering and Innovation, celebrated the remarkable creativity and technical skills of school students from across the state.

This year, over **850 students** from **260 schools** participated in the challenge, competing in two categories: **Junior** (focused on Sustainable Development Goals) and **Senior** (centered on Cyber Physical Systems). The top 10 teams from each category, who were shortlisted after several evaluation rounds, showcased their **working prototypes** during the finale.

In the Junior Category, the Mahendra Muni Saraswati Shishu Vidya Mandir, Madhupur team took home the top prize of ₹25,000 with their project on *Smart City Eliminate Waste Management and Air Pollution*. The project focuses on using IoT and smart sensors to tackle waste management issues and reduce air pollution in urban areas.

In the **Senior Category**, **Kairali School**, **Ranchi** secured the winning title with their innovative project on *Automatic Crop Monitoring and Irrigation System*. This system uses real-time data to optimize water usage in agriculture, promising greater efficiency and sustainability.

The Director of IIT (ISM) Dhanbad, **Prof. Sukumar Mishra**, congratulated all the participants and highlighted the significance of platforms like JH-SIC in fostering a culture of innovation among students.

The evening ended with the award distribution ceremony, where the winning teams were honored with **trophies** and **cash prizes** for their outstanding projects.

Prof. Dheeraj Kumar, Deputy Director, IIT (ISM); Prof Alok Kumar Das, Dean IIE; Prof Rajni Singh, Dean Corporate Communication and others including Prof. R Anand were also present during the function.
