Host IIT (ISM) emerged overall winner by fetching 88 points in three day Inter college sports meet of IIT (ISM), Parakram '24, held from March 8 to 10 at IIT (ISM) which concluded on Sunday evening with the prize distribution function during which Prof MK Singh, Dean (Academic) of IIT (ISM) and Anup D'Costa, renowned Volleyball Player were present as Guests. IIT Kharagpur on other hand bagged the second prize by securing 54 points.

A host of events including, Football, Volleyball, Basketball, Kabbadi, Athletics, Badminton, Table Tennis, Squash, Chess, Power lifting Karate etc were held during the three day event during which participants from IIT Kharagpur, IIT Jodhpur, NIT Agartala, NIT Jamshedpur, NIT Rourkela, NIT Roorkee, ISER Kolkata, Amity Jharkhand, Arka Jain University, BIT Sindri, St Xavier Ranchi and others took part.

Giving details of the results of different events, Prof ACS Rao, Associate Professor, Department of Computer Science Engineering who is also the President of Sports and Physical Education Centre (SPEC) of IIT (ISM) said, "In Table Tennis, IIT (ISM) Boys team emerged winner by defeating IIT Jodhpur while in Girls event, NIT Jamshedpur emerged winner by defeating IIT (ISM) in the finals"

In Karate IIT (ISM) bagged the top spot while IIT Kharagpur was declared runners up. In individual girl's event of Karate, Veer Gatha of IIT Kharagpur clinched the top spot while Purna Lala of IIT (ISM) was declared runner up.

In power lifting Sandip of BIT Sindri emerged winner in 56 KG class by lifting 300 KG while AVV Surya Prasad of IEST Shibpur bagged the runners up trophy by lifting 272 KG. In 62 KG Class, Deepak Kumar Chandrvashi of St Xavier College emerged winner by lifting 395.5 KG while Debraj of NIT Agartalla bagged the second position by lifting 378 KG.

In 68 KG Class, Aman Gautam of NIT Agartalla emerged as the winner by lifting 406 KG while Nilesh Kumar of IIT (ISM) Dhanbad emerged runner up with his feat of 395 KG. In 74 KG Class, Dennis Neer Lakra of St Xavier emerged winner by lifting 539 kg while Kundan Yadav of NIT Rourkela bagged the second position by lifting 430 kg. In 74+ Class Arman Ansari of BIT Sindri, emerged as topper by lifting 537 KG while Kushal Rana of IEST Shibpur bagged the runners up position.
