President of India Graces 45th Convocation of IIT (ISM) Dhanbad during Its Centenary Year Dhanbad, August 1, 2025

The Hon'ble President of India, Smt. Droupadi Murmu, graced the 45th Convocation Ceremony of the Indian Institute of Technology (Indian School of Mines), Dhanbad, today, marking a historic occasion during the centenary year of the institute. She encouraged the institute to be a torchbearer in this endeavour and to continue aligning research with sustainability and inclusivity.

The Hon'ble President underlined that India's greatest strength lies in its vast pool of human resources. The growing access to technical education and digital skills is empowering the nation and pushing it closer to becoming a technological superpower. She remarked that a practical, innovation-driven, and industry-aligned education system is essential to unlock the full potential of India's youth and to enable them to excel on the global stage.

In her message to students, the Hon'ble President stressed the importance of interdisciplinary learning, holistic thinking, and creativity to solve complex global challenges. She also emphasized the need to foster a patent culture along with research and development, and to promote entrepreneurship and start-up ecosystems to help India compete at a global level.

She advised graduating students not to limit their education to personal success alone, but to use their knowledge for public good. She called upon them to build a stronger and more equitable India, one where development takes place in harmony with nature. She urged them to ensure that their future endeavours reflect empathy, excellence, ethics, and a commitment to sustainable progress. "Innovation driven by compassion is what truly makes the world better," she concluded.

The Hon'ble Governor of Jharkhand, Shri Santosh Kumar Gangwar, also addressed the convocation and congratulated the graduating students. He acknowledged the institute's contribution to research, innovation, and national progress. He emphasized that IIT (ISM) bears a special responsibility in harmonizing the critical areas of energy, environment, and mineral resource management through advanced research and technological interventions. He also stressed the importance of making education more inclusive and accessible to all sections of society.

Hon'ble Union Minister of Education, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan, while delivering his address, described the convocation as a significant milestone in the lifelong journey of learning.
