He is also accredited by NABET-QCI as a functional area expert in Geology, Land Use, and Hydrogeology for the preparation of Environmental Impact Assessments (EIA). Among his numerous accolades is the Prize Book Award for securing the top position in M.Sc. (Geology) from Patna University.

Prof. Singh's research interests encompass a broad range of critical areas, including Groundwater Quality and Quantity Assessment, Environmental Geochemistry, Environmental Hydrogeology, Remote Sensing and GIS applications in Environmental Management, Noise Pollution, and Soil Quality Assessment. His dedication to advancing knowledge in these domains is evident through his guidance of over 22 Ph.D. scholars and numerous impactful publications.
