The Collaborative Doctoral Program (CDP) is a joint effort made by both IIT (ISM) Dhanbad (home institution) and Curtin University (Host institution) for the award of a Doctoral degree.

Prof RM Bhattacharjee, Dean, IRAA, while giving details said that , “The CDP is an opportunity given to all registered and eligible PhD scholars to pursue the **Collaborative Doctoral** Program and the PhD degree to be awarded by both the Institutes/Universities under the agreement of Collaborative Doctoral Program between IIT (ISM) Dhanbad and the Foreign Universities/Institutions.”

“The objective of CDP to strengthen the academic ambience and research capabilities of both the collaborative institutes in the areas of identified specializations and to ensure a new opportunity to the PhD scholars who are interested to pursue their research work in any foreign Institutes/Universities of international repute” elaborated Prof Bhattacharjee.

It is noteworthy that the students pursuing CDP will be awarded with one single joint degree, bearing the logo of both the home Institute and the host Institute/University.

The student will follow a program of doctoral research supervised by researchers from both Institutions.
