Ten day “Training for Trainers” course for ‘Enhancing the Skilling Power of Trainers/Teachers’ launched at IIT (ISM) Dhanbad under the PMKVY 4.0.

The ten day “Training for Trainers” course for ‘Enhancing the Skilling Power of Trainers/Teachers’ scheduled from August 30, 2024 to September 9, 2024 was inaugurated today at the Executive Development Centre (EDC) of IIT (ISM) under the scheme of PMKVY 4.0 and NSDC.

Smt Srimoyee Mitra, Deputy General Manager, Government Programs, NSDC, who attended the inaugural function in online mode as Chief Guest said, “Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojna (PMKVY) is a flagship program of the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship”

“We have been implementing this scheme since 2015 and it now more than nine years since we launched the scheme” said Mitra.

“The objective of this scheme is skill certification and enabling youth of the country in relevant skills, which are upcoming in the market, futuristic skills related to industry and new technologies which are being implemented.

“We have a vision under PMKVY 4.0 for providing skills to the workforce and the program we are conducting today is a unique program launched for 1st time to train the trainers” further said Mitra.

She also lauded the role of IIT (ISM) which has been imparting skill development training for more than one year and further said, “The trainers are the heart of any training program so the training is quite significant”

Prof. Dheeraj Kumar, Deputy Director, IIT (ISM) who presided over inaugural function said, “It is a momentous occasion as the inaugural program of the ‘Training for Trainers’ course being held today coincides with the valedictory function of training programme for mine surveyors and only the Department of Mining Engineering can achieve such fetes”

He further said that besides the training in Mine Surveying technology some motivations classes and etiquette and behaviour training will also be imparted as part of the ten day training.
