Two-Day All IITs International Relations Conclave Concludes at IIT (ISM) Dhanbad

The All IITs International Relations (IR) Conclave 2024 successfully concluded at IIT (ISM) Dhanbad on December 13, 2024. This significant event, part of the institute's Centenary Celebrations, took place over two days, from December 12 to 13, and brought together representatives from all 23 IITs across India.

Themed 'STUDY IN INDIA,' the conclave focused on three pivotal aspects of internationalization: Networking & Support, Internationalization, and Study in India.
