Central Library in association with Springer Nature, conducted a workshop, titled “Writing and Publishing Scientific Articles” at Golden Jubilee Lecture Theatre of IIT (ISM) today for budding authors and especially for the newly admitted research scholars and students during which, Ms Suvira Srivastav, Publishing Director, Journals, Springer Nature, apprised the gathering about best practices in scientific writing and publishing; common pitfalls; tips for successful publications; ethical issues; benefits of open access publishing model and other aspects.

The two hour workshop, which began at 10.30 a.m. and concluded at 12.30 p.m. was attended by large number of newly joined Assistant Professors of the institute.

Ms Srivastava, who has extensive experience of conducting author workshop for research communities across the countries of Asia Pacific and UK during her interactive session gave details of common mistakes made by authors while carrying out scientific writing like, using of wrong statistics, unclear research/hypothesis aim, etc.

She later delved deep into the ethical issues in writing and gave tips for successful publication to the participants.

Prof Ajay Mandal, Professor in Charge, Central Library, who was present during workshop apprised the gathering of such workshops in understanding the basics of Scientific Writing.

The workshop is part of series under which an Orientation Session on “Academic Research and Understanding of the Basics of Getting Published” was organized on June 6 during which Ms. Sumita Sen, Regional Customer Training and Implementation Manager, Oxford University Press (OUP) for North and East Europe, South and South East Asia, Middle East and Africa Online Resources gave details of ways of writing a manuscript, talked about differences between a thesis & article and also guided the participants about how to select which journal you want to write for.
