ISAMP Best Thesis Award

Announcement for the Year 2024

The ISAMP Best Thesis award is given to a young researcher in recognition of his/her outstanding contributions during Ph.D. and the overall impact of his/her thesis in the field of Atomic, Molecular and Optical Physics in India.

The award carries a citation and a cash prize of **Rs. 10000/-** only.

NOMINATION AND SELECTION PROCEDURE

- The nomination should be made by a life member of the Society.
- The nomination should be forwarded through the Thesis Supervisor or the Head of Department.
- The nominee must have already submitted the thesis to a University in India. The work presented in the thesis should be either theoretical or experimental Atomic, Molecular and Optical Physics.
- Nominations will be considered for candidates who have submitted their thesis during 15th December 2022 and 15th December 2024.
- Candidates must enclose a brief CV along with the nomination.
- The nominations will be examined by the award committee, which includes the ISAMP President, Secretary and three other members appointed by ISAMP Executive Committee.
- Short-listed candidates will be asked to make a presentation at the forthcoming National Conference (24th NCAMP, January 2025) of the Society.
