ISAMP Young Scientist Award Announcement for the Year 2024

The ISAMP Young Scientist award is given to a young Indian scientist in recognition of his/her outstanding contributions to the growth of Atomic, Molecular and Optical Physics in India by way of theoretical/experimental research in the field.

The award was initially instituted by the Indian Society of Atomic and Molecular Physics (ISAMP) from the endowment given to the society by Prof. S.N. Ghosh.

The prize money is given through society funds and since year 2020 the award has been renamed as ISAMP Young Scientist Award.

GUIDELINES FOR THE AWARD

- The award shall be given biennially to a young Indian scientist in recognition of outstanding contributions to the growth of Atomic and Molecular Physics in India by way of theoretical/experimental research in the field.
- The award shall be made to a person resident or domiciled in India and of age less than 37 years on 1 January of the year for which the award is made (< 37 years on 1 Jan 2025).
- The award will carry a citation and a cash grant of **Rs 20,000/-** only. It may be given individually or jointly.

NOMINATIONS AND SELECTION PROCEDURE

- Candidates will be judged on the basis of published work, contribution towards instrument development and/or new applications of techniques, carried out in India in the field of Atomic, Molecular and Optical Physics. Primarily post Ph.D. work should be cited. The candidate shall have affiliation to an institution in India.
- Nominations for the award in the prescribed format (<https://www.isamp.in/awards>) can be made by a life Member of ISAMP who has personal knowledge of the work of the nominee and shall be supported by at least one more member of ISAMP.
- Nominations shall be accompanied by a detailed write up (not exceeding 1000 words) on the candidate's contributions. The write up should clearly bring out the independent contribution by the nominee to the field, beyond his/her Ph.D.
- The nominations will be examined by the award committee, which includes the ISAMP President, Secretary and three other members appointed by ISAMP Executive Committee. The short listed candidates will be asked to make a presentation at the forthcoming National Conference (24th NCAMP, Jan. 2025) of the Society.
